

Whole house water shut-off in SilverCreek.

Indoor plumbing repairs can be accomplished by turning off the water valve, usually located in the garage or under a sink.

Repairs to plumbing before the house shutoff requires the water to be shut off to several units at the same time at the meter. **This can only be done by St George City water department personnel.**

Any repair requiring the water to be shut off to the property, e.g.; replace the house shutoff valve, the owner should schedule the repair with a licensed plumber, then notify a Board member of the date and time that the water at the meter needs to be turned off. See contact info below.

Only a Board member is allowed to schedule shutting off the entire line. The City will shut the water off then turn it back on after the repair is complete. Further, the owner should notify the property manager or board member of the date and length of time. An email will then be sent to affected owners of the interruption of service. **Only St George City is allowed to turn off water at the meter.**
